

## Guest Writer Agreement

- (V) The term "Articles" will also include all articles previously submitted by you and published by Webmaster Ops LTD.

You agree to indemnify Webmaster Ops LTD and hold it harmless from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including court costs and reasonable fees and expenses of attorneys, expert witnesses, and other professionals, arising out of or resulting from any action by a third party against Webmaster Ops LTD that is based on any claim that any Article infringes a copyright or other proprietary right or violate a trade secret.
